2. After-School Remediation Programme 2026

As part of our continuous academic support, after-school remedial sessions will be conducted for pupils on a needs basis throughout the term. Teachers will notify parents in advance via the Parent Gateway (PG) if a child is required to stay back after school for remediation.

4. Weighted Assessment and Revision Exercise

Weighted Assessments will be carried out in Terms 2, 3, and 4 for Primary 3 to Primary 5 pupils. For Primary 6 pupils, it will be conducted in Terms 1 and 2, with Preliminary Examinations in Term 3. Primary 1 and Primary 2 pupils will have their Holistic Assessment from Term 1 to Term 4.

5. School Smart Card (SSC) Photo-taking for Primary 1 and 6 pupils

The Ministry of Education (MOE) will conduct the yearly photo-taking exercise for all Primary 1 and 6 pupils for the issue of School Smart Cards (SSC) on **Monday, 26 January 2026**. Primary 1 pupils will receive their SSC by the end of March 2026. The photos of Primary 6 pupils will be used for their Secondary SSC when they are promoted to Secondary 1 in 2027.

6. SwimSafer 2.0 Programme for Primary 3 and 6 Pupils

The school will be conducting the SwimSafer 2.0 programme for all P3 and P6 pupils this year. This National Water Safety Programme is designed to emphasise the importance of safety around aquatic environments. The programme aims to teach swimming proficiency and water survival skills in a fun manner.

Our Primary 3 pupils will be having their programme in Term 3. The dates and dismissal timings are indicated in the table below.
