Dear Parents/Guardians,

As Term 1 has drawn to a close, we would like to thank you for your support and continued partnership. As we embark on the next term, the following are matters for your attention.

1. School-based Assessments (SBA) in Term 2

- In line with MOE's announcement on developing learners holistically and reducing emphasis on grades¹, please note that there will be **no Mid-Year Examinations (MYE) for all levels** with effect from this year.
- Primary 1 and 2 will continue with their Holistic Assessment (HA) while Primary 4 to 6 will have their Weighted Assessment (WA).

2. Primary 6 June Holidays Supplementary Lessons and Chillax

- During the June school holidays, supplementary lessons will be conducted from **21 June (Wednesday) to 23 June (Friday)** for Primary 6 students. Lessons will begin at 8.00 am and end at 1.00 pm for all three days.
- On the last day of the supplementary lessons i.e., **23 June (Friday)**, the school will be organising the Primary 6 Chillax for all Primary 6 students from 2.00 pm to 5.00 pm.

5. Applied Learning Programme (ALP)

Through our Applied Learning Programme (ALP), Environmental Science Programme, Si Ling Primary inculcates in our students the mindset and habits to C.A.R.E. – an acronym which stands for Conserve, Appreciate and Respect the Environment. Our students will grow to be stewards in environmental sustainability.

As part of this programme, we have developed a sustainability concept store, called EcoMart, where students learn how a simple act of buying sustainable goods and services can reduce carbon emissions, save natural resources, and reduce waste. EcoMart offers carefully curated products and displays. It also provides opportunities for students to practise responsible and informed decision-making in an authentic and engaging setting.

EcoMart is also home to our Vertical Farming initiative where our students can experience farm life without ever having to leave the city. They discover how locally produced food is fresher, and requires less energy to produce and transport.

To extend our students' ALP C.A.R.E. experience, Si Ling has also partnered with Woodgrove CCC to bring urban farming and the green message into our community. Last year, we piloted the Edible City Farm (ECF) in the community, where our student Environment Ambassadors share the techniques (and vegetable harvests) of urban farming with Woodgrove residents. In addition to sustainability education for our residents, the ECF is Si Ling Primary's contribution to rejuvenation and sprucing up efforts in Woodgrove.
