Dear Parents/Guardians,

As Term 1 has drawn to a close, we would like to thank you for your strong support and partnership in the holistic development of your child/ward.

1. Safe Management Measures (SMM)

Our students have done us proud in exhibiting adaptability and discipline in observing Safe Management Measures such as mask wearing, wiping down as well as taking their own temperature.

For the safety and well-being of our students, the school continues with the Safe Management Measures to fight against COVID-19. Students who are unwell should not come to school and should consult a doctor. Students with household members (18 years old and above) who are sick with fever and/or flu-like symptoms should not come to school.

2. School Programme/Events

2.1 Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Fortnight Programme

Annually, our Mother Tongue (MT) department organises the MTL Fortnight for our students in Si Ling Primary School. The MTL Fortnight serves as a reminder to our students to stay rooted in their own respective cultures, while embracing Singapore as a multicultural and multilingual society. The MT department will be organising a two-week programme comprising a range of interesting and engaging activities in authentic situations for our student during MT periods from 22 March to 1 April 21. The hands-on activities are good platform to promote the cultural riches in the respective MT languages.

2.2 Math Fun Week

In Si Ling Primary, we believe that 'Math is Fun, Math is Alive, Math is not just Worksheets'. Math Fun Week is held annually to engage students with fun-filled mathematics activities from 12 to 16 April 21. Students get to explore and learn more about mathematics through games and play!

2.3 Students Leaders' Engagement

The Students' Engagement session in June is an extension to our student leadership workshop. It provides the opportunity for our selected Primary 3 to 5 student leaders to serve the community as they plan and conduct outreach activities with North West CDC based on the leadership skills that they have learnt.

2.4 Chillax Programme for Primary 6 Students

The school will be organizing the Chillax for P6 students on the 25 June (Fri), the last day of school holidays lessons from 2pm to 5pm. The students will be engaged in fun-filled activities together with their teachers. It is an opportunity for P6 students to take a break with their teachers and peers to allow their body and mind to reenergize as they prepare for PSLE. This will also be a platform to recognize students who have shown resilience and achieved improvement academically.

3. School-based Assessments in Term 2

3.1 Mid-Year Examination for Primary 4 and 6

Please note that **only** Primary 4 and 6 will be having Mid-Year Examinations. It will commence from 4 May (Tue), starting with Oral Examination, to 21 May (Fri). Please refer to the attached Term 2 Calendar of Events for details.

3.2 Weighted Assessment (WA) and Holistic Assessment (HA)

Primary 1 and 2 will continue with their Holistic Assessment (HA) while Primary 3 and 5 will have their Weighted Assessment (WA). WA will be held from 17 May (Mon) to 24 May (Mon).

4. Primary 3 to 6 Enrichment/ Remedial and P6 Additional Support Lessons

Primary 3 to 6 students selected to attend enrichment/remedial and P6 additional support lessons (**Math only**) in Term 1 will continue to attend the respective lessons in Term 2. Please note that Primary 6 are involved only on Wednesdays as their supplementary lessons are on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
